Everyone who is under the age of 20, is not attending upper secondary school or has no upper secondary school diploma, is covered by the municipality's scheme to ensure gainful activity (*kommunens aktivitetsansvar, KAA*) (Chapter 29, Section 9 of the Swedish Education Act).
